WHERE AS, NPTO Chefs Against Cancer division involves over 400,000 chefs and is growing rapidly worldwide; and




WHERE AS, in the City of Byram, "It's all about supporting the fight against cancer, honoring the survivors and remembering those who will forever live in our hearts;"



"Chefs Appreciation Day"


