

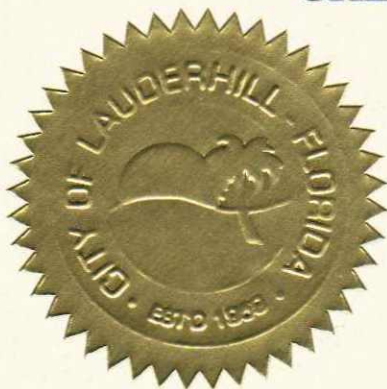


City of Lauderhill **PROCLAMATION**
