**WHEREAS**, few things are better for both the body and the soul than a well-crafted, sublimely prepared and lovingly presented meal; and

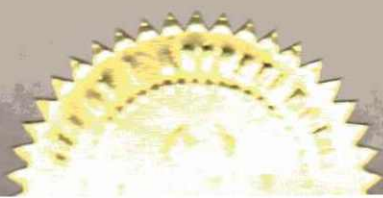
**WHEREAS**, NPTO Chefs Against Cancer division involves over 400,000 chefs and is growing rapidly worldwide; and
